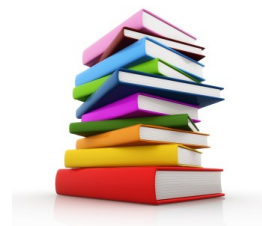

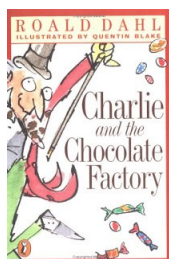


World Book Day
