

Pupil Premium Outcomes 2016

Pupil Premium: Key Stage 2 (SATs) Attainment

Outcomes for the ten disadvantaged pupils in Key Stage 2 assessments show 50% achieved the expected combined standard in all subjects, which is 7% below the school's combined figure, and 3% below the combined national average for all pupils. Disadvantaged pupil outcomes were 7% below cohort in reading, 10% below cohort in maths, 14% below in writing and 15% below in GPS. Outcomes were around one pupil short of being in line with the cohort.

Pupil Premium: Attendance Data

The gap in attendance between the whole school and pupil premium has reduced from 1.03% in 2014-15 to 0.82% in 2015-16.

Pupil Premium: Whole school Teacher Assessment

U = Unable to Assess; E = Emerging or above; D = Developing or above; S = Secure or above; M = Mastered.

Outcomes are shown as percentages. The outcomes for Emerging, Developing and Secure are cumulative (showing the percentage of pupils who are at this level or above).

The expected outcome for most pupils by the end of each year is Secure or above. Data for cohorts is included to enable comparison with the whole class.

Pupil Premium outcomes across Key Stage 1 (Y1-2) are generally pleasing. In Y2, two out of three disadvantaged PP pupils achieved well, and in Year 2 pupil premium outcomes are line with the cohort.

Pupil Premium outcomes across Key Stage 2 (Y3-6) are more variable. Outcomes in Year 5 were in line with the cohort, whereas in Years 3, 4 and 6 outcomes were around 10-15% below. A higher proportion of disadvantaged pupils also have SEND.

There were 53 pupils eligible for pupil premium in summer 2016. Fourteen of those disadvantaged pupils (26%) also had Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). Approximately half the pupils (14/30 or 46%) receiving SEND support also receive Pupil Premium support.

At the end of the summer term in Year 1, two out of the three pupils eligible for pupil premium achieved Secure in all subjects. One pupil achieved Mastered in all subjects.

In Year 2, three out of the four pupils eligible for pupil premium achieved Secure. This is in line with outcomes for the whole class.

In Year 3, one third of the whole class were eligible for pupil premium. Of these pupils, six were at the expected level in writing and maths, with four achieving Secure in reading.

In Year 4, one half of the class were eligible for pupil premium funding. Of these pupils, 58% achieved secure in reading and writing, and 75% for maths.

In Year 5, outcomes for the eight pupils eligible for pupil premium were broadly in line with the cohort. 88% achieved Secure in reading.

In Year 6, six out of the ten pupils eligible for pupil premium were teacher assessed at Secure or above in all subjects, with one achieving Mastered in writing.
